## **SAVELIVES PACKAGE INTERVENTIONS**

### **Speed management**

1. Establish and enforce speed limit laws nationwide, locally and in cities
2. Build or modify roads which calm traffic, such as roundabouts, road narrowing, speed bumps, chicanes and rumble strips
3. Require car makers to install new technologies, like intelligent speed adaptation, to help drivers obey speed limits

### **Leadership**

4. Create an agency to spearhead road safety
5. Develop and fund a road safety strategy
6. Evaluate the impact of road safety strategies
7. Monitor road safety by strengthening data systems
8. Raise awareness and public support through education and campaigns

### **Infrastructure design and improvement**

9. Provide safe infrastructure for all road users including sidewalks, safe crossings, refuges, overpasses and underpasses
10. Put in place dedicated lanes for cyclists and motorcyclists
11. Make the sides of roads safer by using clear zones, collapsible structures or barriers
12. Design safer intersections
13. Separate access roads from through-roads
14. Prioritize people by putting in place vehicle-free zones
15. Restrict traffic and speed in residential, commercial and school zones
16. Provide better, safer routes for public transport

### **Vehicle safety standards**

17. Establish and enforce vehicle safety standard regulations related to:
  - a. seat-belts;
  - b. seat-belt anchorages;
  - c. frontal impact;
  - d. side impact;
  - e. electronic stability control;
  - f. pedestrian protection; and
  - g. ISOFIX child restraint points.
18. Establish and enforce regulations on motorcycle anti-lock braking and daytime running lights

### **Enforcement of traffic laws**

19. Establish and enforce regulations related to:
  - a. Speeding
  - b. Drinking and driving
  - c. Motorcycle helmets
  - d. Seat-belts
  - e. Child restraints

### **Survival after a crash**

20. Develop organized and integrated prehospital and facility-based emergency care systems
21. Train those who respond to crashes in basic emergency care
22. Promote community first responder training
